Third Sunday of Advent

"Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus."

1Thessalonians 5:16-18

Rejoice, pray and give thanks. These are very important words. In this passage, Paul tells us that we should rejoice in the gifts that God has given to us and trust that He will provide for us. This scripture reading sums up Stewardship. "Rejoice always" means place your trust in God; He will provide all that you need. "Pray Constantly" means that we should have regular conversations with God, asking for direction and guidance. "Give thanks" means that we should thank God for all things—good and not so good.

Advent Prayer

Lord, I pray that Christmas would not sneak up on me this year.

I don't want to arrive on Christmas morning with only my gifts wrapped and tasks accomplished. I want a heart that is full and prepared for Your coming.

Help me this season to be active in waiting for You. Give me eyes to see, ears to hear and a heart to understand the signs, beauty, and wonder of the One I am waiting for.

This season, give me an awareness of the carols, the cards, and the people around me.

Remind me of the truths of Christmas: with You all things are possible, even when I am like Zechariah and Mary with hearts that don't understand.

When your promises seem impossible, God remind me once again "with God all things are possible."

This Christmas, fill my heart with the Christmas message.

Don't let fear, pain, and sadness steal Your promises. I want to celebrate You as a promise-making and promise-keeping God.


