




From Father Andy's Desk

Surrounded by Mary

My friends, this weekend, our second reading, after referencing the heroes of the Old Testament in the previous chapter, says, "Since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us and persevere in running the race that lies before us while keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus, the leader and perfecter of faith." The Letter to the Hebrews gives us an image of being surrounded by the saints in heaven. This is meant to give us encouragement in running the race of faith. The saints are friends of Jesus who help us to be friends of Jesus. The greatest is the Blessed Virgin Mary. We are blessed to be surrounded by her. Her presence blesses us with peace. 


