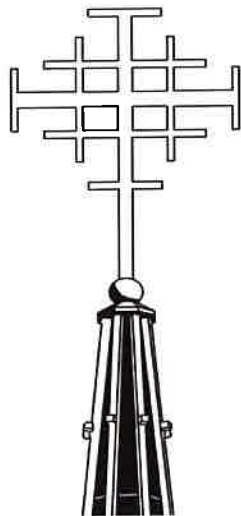

The Lakes Project to Feed Ukrainian Refugees

We are undertaking a project to assist Ukrainian refugees who have fled to Poland. The Youth Groups of St. Joseph's and St. Mary's Parishes are teaming up to both prepare food but also raise awareness of the plight of families who have had to flee their homes due to the Russian invasion of their homeland. Before our eyes a humanitarian crisis is unfolding and more than 7.5 million Ukrainians have fled the fighting. We hope to package between 40,000 and 60,000 meals. This is big undertaking and we will need the help of many volunteers. We also need your financial assistance to help fund this project.
