

We are very grateful for the generosity of many parish members and summer visitors who have generously contributed to our August 10th event to package meals to send to Ukrainian refugees living in Poland. Our "Lakes Project to Feed Ukrainian Refugees" effort is off to a great start. Please note that 100% of your financial contributions will go to providing food directly to refugees. We started out wanting to prépare 40,000 meals but your generosity has allowed us to increase our meal count to more than 85,000. This is amazing. While this project is being led by the youth of Saint Joseph's and Saint Mary's, financial support has come from many sources outside our parishes. We are grateful for the financial assistance given by other local churches and service organizations who have taken up the cause with us. Your generosity has allowed our project to expand to feed more Ukrainian families who are facing difficulties during this crisis. Please continue to pray for peace in Eastern Europe.

Sign-up For Our Ukrainian Food Project

Food preparation for our Ukrainian Refugee Project has been scheduled for Wednesday, August 10 at the Expo Building on the Dickinson County Fairgrounds. We have planned for three work periods; the mid-morning shift runs from 9 a.m. until 11 a.m., the mid-afternoon shift runs from 2 p.m. until 4 p.m. and the evening shifts runs from 6 p.m. until 8 p.m. We are hoping to have 100 volunteers for each of the three work periods for our August 10th event. Wide support and encouragement from local churches and community organizations, school sports teams or activity groups are all helping us to complete our goal. We encourage all to sign up to help with this important effort and invite your friends and neighbors to take a few volunteers spots. We are asking each volunteer to provide us with an email address or cell phone number so that we can be in contact with you in the days just before the August 10th event.
