

# **Religious Education News** By Erin Lorch

Greetings! Happy Advent! It's the beginning on a new liturgical year. I still have memories of Advent as a child. Not only did my home parish have an Advent Wreath with candles off to the side near the ambo, but it also had a massive Advent Wreath with purple and pink ribbons that suspended from the tall, cathedrallike ceiling. It was quite a spectacle then, and I wonder if it would seem just as massive now as an adult. I remember waiting for each candle to be lit, to see our pastor wearing PINK at mass on the 3rd Sunday, for Jesus' birthday, and for the songs we only sing at Christmas. I was excited to see the nativity set complete with porcelain Baby Jesus lying in the manger. The hope and anticipation I felt as a child is how I long to feel again this Advent season. This week, we reflect on HOPE. Hope can be hard for us adults. We calculate the chances of outcomes, we can predict other people's behaviors, we have unresolved hurts and trauma that we think we may never heal from. Life can be so good, but amidst all of the blessings, there are difficulties. Hope is not a false state of mind to have. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Hope is the theological virtue by which we desire the kingdom of heaven and eternal life as our happiness, placing our trust in Christ's promises and relying not on our own strength, but on the help of the grace of the Holy Spirit." (CCC 1817). Even in the most difficult of situations, we believe that with God, there is a way. There is a plan. It may, however, never make sense on this side of heaven. Maybe, with time, it will! Even if...God loves each of us more than we can ever fathom. He is with us and wants us to have hope, the same way so many of the saints hoped. Pray the following prayer for a renewal of hope.
