Pastor's COLUMN

Restoration of Some Beautiful Items

This week we received several items back from metal restoration experts. The original cross above the center tabernacle and the two side tabernacle doors have all been restored and put back in place. The parish chalice that is used often here was also re-plated and will return to regular use. Several months ago we found the

original processional cross in the attic and have had it restored also. We will display it near the fireplace in the lower narthex. Having items like this restored is an expensive venture and we want to say a word of thanks to an anonymous benefactor whose generous gift paid for much of the work. The St Joseph Rosary and Altar Society have also contributed to this venture. Our beautiful church seems a bit brighter this week because of those beautiful restorations.

A Gigantic Christmas Gift

This week we received an incredibly generous gift: Mr. Tom Clary deeded to us a house at 1011 15th Street in Milford. Tom has completely remodeled the interior of the house. The house has been given to us to provide a residence for a retired priest to live here to assist with daily Mass so that we can have Mass each day in both parishes. We are grateful for Tom's generosity but we are especially impressed by Tom's devotion to daily Mass here at St. Joseph and St. Mary's. A retired priest living here among us will also be able to provide valuable assistance to the pastor. Renovations on the house are nearing completion and once all the work has been finished, we will have an Open House so that all of you will be able to see this very nice house. We will keep you posted about the time and date of the Open House. We are grateful for Tom's hard work on this project and many other ventures at St. Joseph and we want to acknowledge this generous gift to the Church here in Dickinson County.

Appliances

Several families have stepped forward and donated furniture for the house at 1011 15th Street. We will need to purchase a few pieces of furniture but we have received enough furniture to set up housekeeping there. We still have one major project that remains. The house has no appliances. We would like to invite members of both parishes to contribute to a fund to purchase the necessary appliances. We will need a refrigerator and stove, a microwave, a dishwasher for the kitchen and a washer and dryer for the laundry. All of you know that these are costly items but we hope that many will consider a contribution to this venture. If we work together, we will be able to complete this project that will be used by our priests for many years to come. This residence for a retired priest will serve the needs of both parishes. If you would like to make a contribution, please make the checks payable to either St. Joseph or St. Mary's and note "appliances" in the memo. A fund for the purchase of these necessary household items will be set up this week.
