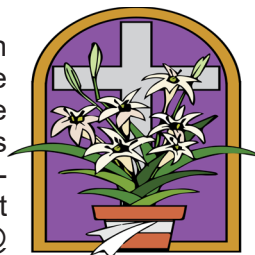
Religious Education News

As many of you know, we have been working on a house at 1011 15th Street, in Milford, to prepare it for retired priests who will assist with Masses and other projects here in Dickinson County. 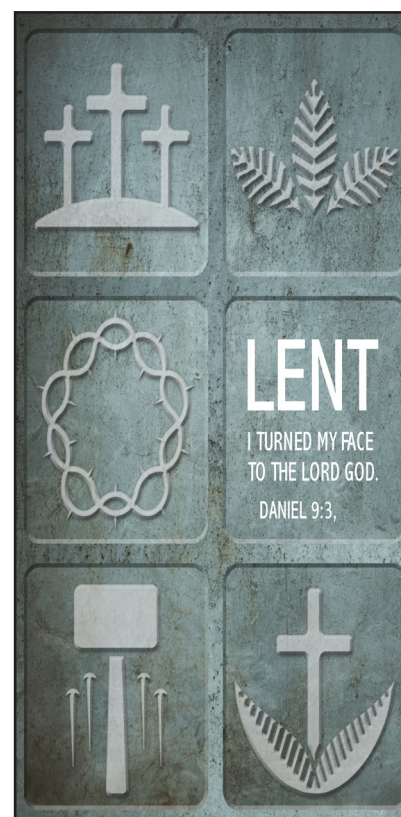

Stewardship REPORT

"If anyone would serve me," says Jesus in today's Gospel, "let him follow me; where I am, there will my servant be." In what ways is Jesus inviting *me* to follow Him? What service is He asking of me?
