


Dear Parishioners,
Greetings to you all from Fr. John Peter.

We have just begun the Month of December and entered the season of Advent. And on December 12th we will celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. There will be the traditional Morning Prayer which is called "Mariachis" at 11:30 pm the day before that is Friday late night. These "Mariachis" sing the whole morning prayer with their instruments and it is quite enriching to watch. This year this feast falls on the Saturday weekend. We will have our regular weekend Masses, but we will also be celebrating the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. There will be the traditional dancing by our own parish Mexican students called as "Matachines" in the Parking lot right after the Saturday Weekend English Mass. And at about 6:30 pm we will process with the Statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe from the Parish Hall to the Church during which the "Matachines" will dance till the procession reaches the Church after which we will have the Mass of the Solemnity of our Lady of Guadalupe. It will be a Spanish Mass with our own choir singing for the Mass. It will be good if you would like to participate in the Mass and experience the culture and traditions of our own brothers and sisters who came from Mexico.

Our Lady of Guadalupe holds a special place in the religious life of Mexico and is one of the most popular religious devotions. Her image has played an important role as a national symbol of Mexico. According to tradition, Mary appeared to Juan Diego, who was a convert to Christianity on December 9 and again on December 12, 1531. During her first apparition she requested that a shrine to her be built on the spot where she appeared, Tepeyac Hill. The local Bishop demanded a sign before he would approve construction of a church, however. Mary then appeared a second time to Juan Diego and ordered him to collect roses. In a second audience with the bishop, Juan Diego opened his cloak, letting dozens of roses fall to the floor and revealing the image of Mary imprinted on the inside of the cloak—the image that is now venerated in the Basilica of Guadalupe.

Our parish has been and continues to be blessed with the young and energetic Hispanic Families. They are so rooted in their culture and tradition and they bring to us so much of value and respect. Their presence in our parish is a big blessing and they bring so much of variety and life to the parish. Our parish is a blend of Anglo's and Hispanics that go together so well without any differences. It shows the unity and oneness of our Parish. We are grateful and happy that they are part of our parish.

I am sure that you are getting busy during this time of the year. Please make use of these festivities to grow in our faith and to come more closer to Christ. Please remember the Church in your generosity.

Estimados feligreses,
Saludos a todos ustedes del P. Juan Pedro.

Acabamos de comenzar el mes de diciembre y entramos en la temporada de Adviento. Y el 12 de diciembre celebraremos la fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. Habrá la tradicional oración de la mañana que se llama "Mañanitas" a las 11:30 pm el día anterior, la noche del viernes. Estarán los "Mariachis" cantando las mañanitas con sus instrumentos y es muy enriquecedor de ver. Este año esta fiesta cae en el fin de semana del sábado. Tendremos nuestras misas regulares de fin de semana pero también celebraremos la Fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. Habrá el baile tradicional de los estudiantes mexicanos de nuestra propia parroquia llamado "Matachines" en el estacionamiento justo después de la misa en inglés del fin de semana del sábado. Y alrededor de las 6:30 pm procesaremos con la estatua de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe de la parroquia. Durante la cual bailarían los "Matachines" hasta que la procesión llegue a la Iglesia luego de lo cual tendremos la Misa de la Solemnidad de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. Será una Misa en español con nuestro propio coro cantando para la Misa. Sería bueno si quisiera participar en la Misa y experimentar la cultura y tradiciones de nuestros propios hermanos y hermanas que vinieron de México.

Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe ocupa un lugar especial en la vida religiosa de México y es una de las devociones religiosas más populares. Su imagen ha jugado un papel importante como símbolo nacional de México. Según la tradición, María se apareció a Juan Diego, quien se convirtió al cristianismo el 9 de diciembre y nuevamente el 12 de diciembre de 1531. Durante su primera aparición pidió que se le construyera un santuario en el lugar donde apareció, el cerro del Tepeyac. Sin embargo, el obispo local exigió una señal antes de aprobar la construcción de una iglesia. Entonces María se apareció por segunda vez a Juan Diego y le ordenó que recogiera rosas. En una segunda audiencia con el obispo, Juan Diego abrió su manto, dejando caer decenas de rosas al suelo y revelando la imagen de María impresa en el interior del manto, la imagen que ahora se venera en la Basílica de Guadalupe.

Nuestra parroquia ha sido y sigue siendo bendecida con familias hispanas jóvenes y enérgicas. Están tan arraigados en su cultura y tradición y nos aportan mucho valor y respeto. Su presencia en nuestra parroquia es una gran bendición y aportan mucha variedad y vida a la parroquia. Nuestra parroquia es una mezcla de anglosajones e hispanos que van muy bien sin diferencias. Muestra la unidad y la identidad de nuestra parroquia. Estamos agradecidos y felices de que sean parte de nuestra parroquia.

Estoy seguro de que se está ocupando durante esta época del año. Utilice estas festividades para crecer en nuestra fe y acercarnos más a Cristo. Por favor, recuerde a la Iglesia en su generosidad.
