

Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you all from Fr. John Peter Swaminathan,

I trust that you are all doing well. The Third Sunday of the Year in the Liturgical year is called the Word of God Sunday that was recently established by our Holy Father Pope Francis as an invitation for us to deepen our appreciation, love and faithful witness to God and his word. A day dedicated to the Bible will help the Church "experience anew how the risen Lord opens up for us the treasury of his word and enables us to proclaim its unfathomable riches before the world," the pope said in the document establishing the special Sunday observance. "The Bible is the most widely distributed book in the world. With this apostolic letter, the pope "invites us to hold the word of God in our hands every day as much as possible so that it becomes our prayer" and a greater part of one's lived experience, he said. In his letter, Francis wrote, "A day devoted to the Bible should not be seen as a yearly event but rather a yearlong event, for we urgently need to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures and of the risen Lord, who continues to speak his word and to break bread in the community of believers." "We need to develop a closer relationship with sacred Scripture; otherwise, our hearts will remain cold and our eyes shut, struck as we are by so many forms of blindness," he wrote. Sacred Scripture and the sacraments are inseparable, he wrote. Jesus speaks to everyone with his word in sacred Scripture, he said, and if people "hear his voice and open the doors of our minds and hearts, then he will enter our lives and remain ever with us." "The Bible is the book of the Lord's people, who, in listening to it, move from dispersion and division toward unity" as well as come to understand God's love and become inspired to share it with others, he added.

I hope that we have enough time to read the scripture, reflect on it and make it part of our lives. Hope to see you all in the Church.

Estimados feligreses

Saludos a todos ustedes del P. Juan Pedro Swaminathan,

Confío en que todos lo estén haciendo bien. El tercer domingo del año en el año litúrgico se llama Domingo de la Palabra de Dios y fue establecido recientemente por nuestro Santo Padre el Papa Francisco como una invitación para que profundicemos nuestro aprecio, amor y testimonio fiel de Dios y su palabra. Un día dedicado a la Biblia ayudará a la Iglesia a "experimentar de nuevo cómo el Señor resucitado nos abre el tesoro de su palabra y nos permite proclamar sus insondables riquezas ante el mundo", dijo el Papa en el documento que establece la observancia especial del domingo. "La Biblia es el libro de mayor distribución en el mundo. Con esta carta apostólica, el Papa "nos invita a tener la palabra de Dios en nuestras manos todos los días tanto como sea posible para que se convierta en nuestra oración" y en una mayor parte de la experiencia vivida, dijo. En su carta, Francisco escribió: "Un día dedicado a la Biblia no debe verse como un evento anual, sino más bien como un evento de un año, porque necesitamos con urgencia crecer en nuestro conocimiento y amor de las Escrituras y del Señor resucitado, que continúa hablando su palabra y partiendo el pan en la comunidad de los creyentes". "Necesitamos desarrollar una relación más cercana con la Sagrada Escritura; de lo contrario, nuestros corazones permanecerán fríos y nuestros ojos cerrados, golpeados como estamos por tantas formas de ceguera", escribió. La Sagrada Escritura y los sacramentos son inseparables, escribió. Jesús les habla a todos con su palabra en las Sagradas Escrituras, dijo, y si la gente "escucha su voz y abre las puertas de nuestra mente y corazón, entonces él entrará en nuestras vidas y permanecerá para siempre con nosotros". "La Biblia es el libro del pueblo del Señor que, al escucharla, pasa de la dispersión y la división a la unidad", así como llega a comprender el amor de Dios y se inspira para compartirlo con los demás, agregó.

Espero que tengamos suficiente tiempo para leer las Escrituras, reflexionar sobre ellas y hacerlas parte de nuestras vidas.
