Guidelines for the Sacraments

<u>First Communion:</u> Children must attend a full year of First Grade Religious Education (RE) before being admitted into the 2nd grade First Communion Class.

<u>Confirmation:</u> Students must attend 6th or 7th grade RE classes before being admitted into the Confirmation class. If a student did not attend RE classes last year, the student will need to attend this year's RE classes in order to qualify for the Confirmation program.

Parents: must be registered in the parish 6 months prior to enrolling their children in Sacrament classes. Families who have not been registered in the parish are not eligible for the First Communion or Confirmation program for this year.
