Fast & Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 60. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Friday Evening Mass, Stations of the Cross and Soup Sup-

per: In order to encourage more people to participate in the Lenten Fridays, we will have Masses on Friday only during Lent at **6pm**, followed by Stations of the Cross in English and conclude with a soup supper served in the Parish Hall at **7pm** by parish organizations. Please make use of this opportunity to participate in the sufferings of Christ on Friday's.

Ash Wednesday, 22nd of February

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the season of Lent. The ashes we receive on our forehead in the shape of a cross serve as an outward sign of our sinfulness and need for penance. *It is a day of fast and abstinence when ashes are blessed and imposed on the foreheads of the faithful to remind them of their obligation to do penance of sins, to seek spiritual renewal by means of prayer, fasting, good works and by bearing with patience and for God's purposes the trials and difficulties of everyday life. The ashes are used to mark t forehead with the Sign of the Cross, with the reminder: "Remember you are dust, and to dust you will return," or: "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel."*
