



June 7th & June 8th Pentecost Sunday

Pentecost, observed fifty days after Easter, is a significant Christian holiday that commemorates the coming of the Holy Spirit to the apostles. It marks the birth of the Church and the fulfillment of Jesus' promise to send a "helper".

The event, described in Acts 2, depicts the apostles being empowered by the Holy Spirit to proclaim the Good News in diverse languages, signifying God's desire to save all people.

The “**Central Message of Pentecost**”, a significant Christian holiday, is the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples, fulfilling Jesus' promise and empowering them to be witnesses. This event marks the beginning of the church's mission and the empowerment of believers to spread the gospel.



7 Blessings of Pentecost

God has set an appointed time—and Pentecost is that moment. In Deuteronomy 28, He outlines seven powerful blessings for those who obey His command: power, peace, protection, presence, provision, perfection, and prosperity
