<u> Most Holy Trinity Sunday</u>

On Trinity Sunday, the faithful remember and honor the eternal God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Trinity Sunday lasts only one day, which is symbolic of the unity of the Trinity.

Trinity Sunday's core message revolves around the Christian doctrine of the Trinity, which states that there is one God who exists in three co-equal and co-eternal persons: the Father, the Son (Jesus), and the Holy Spirit. It emphasizes both the unity and distinctiveness of God's three persons, affirming that they are intimately related and work together in love and unity.


