



## June 21st & June 22nd Corpus Christi Sunday

The Solemnity of the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**. The feast day honors the Eucharist, the Body and Blood of Christ, and emphasizes the belief in the Real Presence. The celebration often includes a Mass and a procession where the Blessed Sacrament, consecrated bread, is carried through the streets.



**The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus**, is always celebrated on the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi. The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has its roots in apparitions of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17th century, where he asked that a feast be established in honor of his Heart. The Sacred Heart symbolizes Jesus' divine love for humanity, especially demonstrated through his sacrifice on the cross. The entire month of June is traditionally dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Pope Pius IX made it a universal feast in 1856.

## The Nativity of Saint John the Baptist

John the Baptist was an ascetic Jewish prophet known in Christianity as the forerunner of Jesus. John was sanctified in the womb at that moment, meaning he was freed from sin and prepared for his sacred mission of preparing the way for Jesus' ministry.

John preached about God's Final Judgment and baptized repentant followers in preparation for it. Jesus was among the recipients of his rite of baptism.



**The Immaculate Heart of Mary** refers to Mary's interior heart, which remained sinless and devoted to God despite the challenges and sorrows she encountered on earth. The feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary is a memorial that takes place immediately following the Feast of the Sacred Heart, a devotion to which the Immaculate Heart is closely associated.
