



sin of the world!" He doesn't say "the sins of the world;" he uses the singular: "the sin of the away the sins of the world" (Lamb of God). The recently developed concept of social sin is an different manifestations of our sinfulness. The liturgy alternates between these two perspectives at different times. We can speak of "sins" (in the plural), but all our sins are of a piece: they are world" (peccatum in Latin, ten hamarten in Greek).
