

The Mystery of the Trinity

The human mind cannot fully comprehend the mystery of the Trinity, but it can be summarized as follows: **God is three Persons in one Nature.**

There is only one God, and the three Persons of God—the **Father, the Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit**—are all equally God and cannot be divided.

Symbolism:

Sunday holds special significance for each Person of the Trinity:

The Father (Creator) began the work of creation on the first day of the week.

The Son (Redeemer) rose from the dead on Sunday.

The Holy Spirit (Sanctifier) descended upon the infant Church on Sunday.

Therefore, Sunday is considered the day of the Most Holy Trinity

In summary, Trinity Sunday serves as a time for Christians to reflect on the mystery of the Triune God and respond with joy and thanksgiving to the love shown by the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in accomplishing the salvation of humanity.
