
# **Knight & Family of the Month**

### **Culture of Life — Abortion is Murder**

"Abortion is murder: the church cannot change its position," the pope [Pope Francis] said. He added, "Whoever has an abortion, kills. No mincing words."

"Take any book on embryology for medical students," he said. "The third week after conception, all the organs are already there, even the DNA. ... it is a human life, this human life must be respected, this principle is so clear! To those who cannot understand, I would ask this question: Is it right to kill a human life to solve a problem? Is it right to hire a hitman to kill a human life? Scientifically, it is a human life. Is it right to take it out to solve a problem? That is why the church is so harsh on this issue, because if it accepts this, it is as if it accepts daily murder."

The U.S. Supreme Court has set the date of December 1 to begin hearing arguments in a case that directly challenges the constitutionality of Roe v. Wade, the 1973 ruling that legalized abortion in all 50 states. The case, called Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health, will decide the validity of a Mississippi law that bans abortions after 15 weeks of gestation. In December, attorneys will begin presenting arguments against a lower court ruling which stopped the Mississippi pro-life law from being enforced.

Leaders of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) denounced the Biden administration for attempting to massively fund abortions with taxpayer dollars through the Build Back Better Act, the Democrats' proposed \$3.5 reconciliation bill. The text of the bill "funds abortion, the deliberate destruction of our most vulnerable brothers and sisters – those in the womb," wrote Archbishop Joseph Naumann, chairman of the USCCB's Committee on Pro-Life Activities, and Archbishop Paul Coakley, chairman of the USCCB's Committee on Domestic Justice and Human Development in a statement Friday [September 17, 2021].

#### **STATE AND LOCAL NEWS**

Passed and signed into Texas law for 2021:

SB 1 - Included a 25% increase in funding for the Alternatives to Abortion program.

SB 4 - Bans mail order abortions and establishes safety protocols for chemical abortions

SB 8 – Texas Heartbeat Act – protects a baby with a heartbeat from abortion (Preliminary injunction filed by PPH to the US Supreme Court. By a 5 to 4 vote the Court denied the injunction.]

"Today [September 1, 2021], Texas law SB8 went into effect. This extreme Texas law blatantly violates the constitutional right established under <u>Roe v. Wade</u> and upheld as precedent for nearly half a century. The Texas law will significantly impair women's access to the health care they need, particularly for communities of color and individuals with low incomes," Biden said.

In a one-page opinion released Thursday [September 16, 2021], U.S. District Judge Robert Pittman rejected the request of the U.S. Department of Justice to issue a temporary restraining order or preliminary injunction against Texas' Senate Bill 8. The law, which went into effect Sept. 1, bans abortion after a fetal heartbeat can be detected, usually around six weeks gestation. It also allows private citizens to sue individuals who perform abortions and those who help women obtain illegal abortions.

HB 1280 - Human Life Protection Act is triggered if Roe v. Wade is overturned.
