



St. Joanna The Myrrh Bearer

Joanna was a follower of Jesus and one of the women who came to the tomb with "spices and ointments" to anoint the body of Jesus. Joanna is named by the Orthodox Church as one of the women who came to the tomb, found it empty and attended by angels. They returned to the Apostles to tell them that the angels had said that Christ was risen from the dead. Their testimony was initially dismissed but later turned out to be true.

The women who followed Jesus in the early Church were not always mentioned by name, but were significant in that they were the first (including Mary Magdalene) to tell of the Resurrection.


