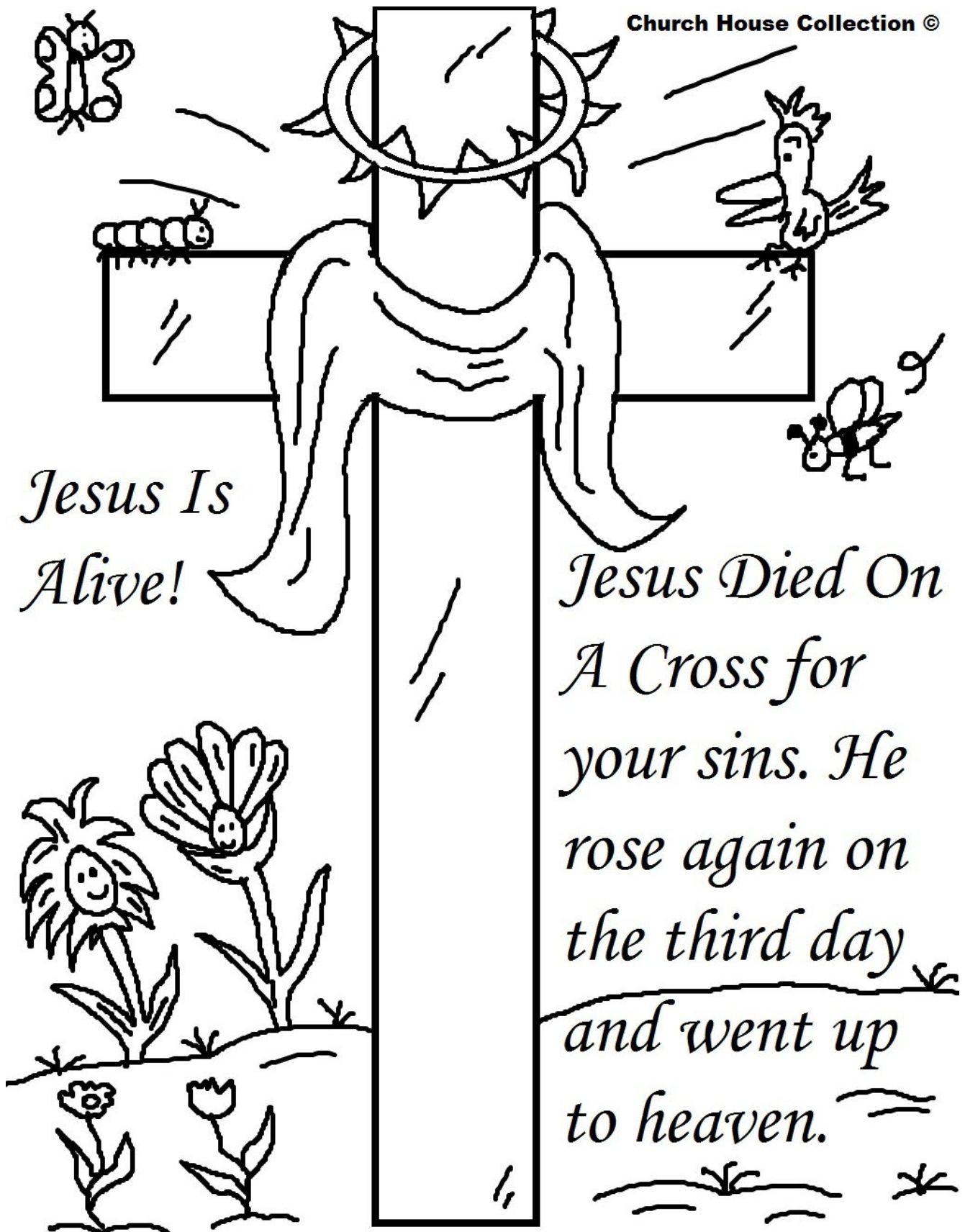

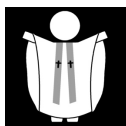

### For Grades K – 8th

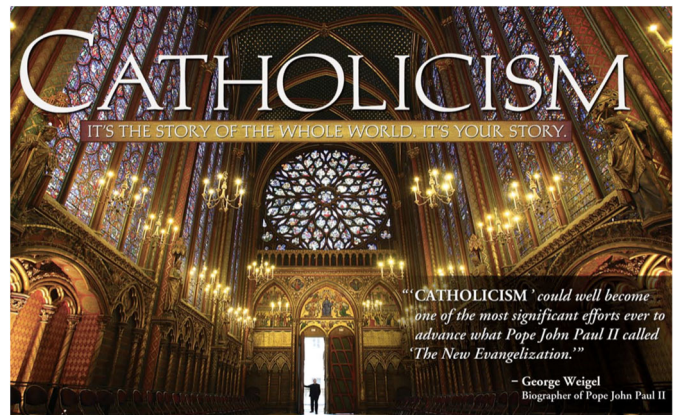
Early bird registration for Faith Formation will begin in May. Information on how to register for the 2020-2121 school year will be posted soon.

#### Faith

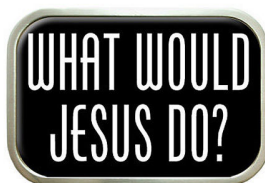
Wow! You might want to take some time and reflect again on Acts 2:42-47. Think of what passed before you and around you this past several weeks; news stories, Facebook, Instagram, emails. What did you think about, say, or do? People were reaching out to connect. The Gospel of John tells us "through the breath of Jesus we were given the Holy Spirit." The Holy Spirit works to build our relationship with Jesus and move us to be more like Jesus in words, thoughts and actions.

Over the last few weeks, most of us have been given:

- 1) Ready access to Mass any time of the day.
- 2) The opportunity to share time, talent, and treasure.
- 3) Devotion thru Spiritual Communion.
- 4) Time for prayer along with a wealth of resources from different mediums.

Each of these activities deepens our relationship with the risen Jesus and God, all in the unity of the Holy Spirit.

As we continue to build our relationship with Jesus and strengthen our faith, we also are called to be ministers of God's Word and share it with others amongst our family of believers and to others who might be listening.
