

### Fast from darkness...feast on LIGHT!

Lent literally means spring. It is a time of rebirth, of change, of transformation. Recently on a zoom call with

Sr. Rebecca Shinas OP, she said,
"THE LIGHT OF GOD'S LOVE SHINES
BRIGHTLY WITHIN YOU!"

Imagine that! God's bright light of love radiating within our hearts. Sr. Rebecca adds, "During Lent, we do not open our hearts to let God *in*. Rather we open our hearts to let God *out*!" We are called to share God's bright light of love with others. Sr. Rebecca uses as acronym for the word CHANGE:

to Have

New

God

Experience

This "New God Experience" is exactly what the woman at the well had with Jesus. Jesus met her face to face. He knew her heart as well as her long history of poor choices, sins. Yet he saw her with eyes of love and understanding. He saw the real person under all the wrong choices. He knew who she was created to be. This outcast woman from Samaria asked Jesus to give the real water. She said, "I know that the Messiah is coming, the one called the Christ." Jesus said, "I am he, the one who is speaking with you." Her faith caused her to go tell this good news to her fellow Samaritans. Many came to believe in Jesus. The Samaritan woman is considered to be Jesus' first disciple. What about you and me?
