



How to 'make sacred' your Lenten practice of fasting

We are half-way through Lent...a time of transformation and change. CHANGE is a Chance to Have A New God Experience. In Bishop Cantu's homily on Ash Wednesday, he focused on Fasting, readily admitting he does not like to suffer. Then he offered another word for 'suffer': the word 'sacrifice'. To sacrifice means to 'make sacred'. Therefore, we make sacred our Lenten sacrifices. We offer our sacrifices out of love for God, out of love for our neighbor, out of love for ourselves. Parents often offer sacrifices for their children. They just do it out of love. God is LOVE. God invites us to love in return, leading us to reach out to our neighbors.

Jesus offered his life on the cross as a sacrifice – He 'made sacred' his life out of love for his father and out of love for each one of us.

And so, half-way through Lent, we have the chance to have a new God experience. Look at your sacrifices. See them as 'sacred'-offered to God out of love. In what ways, out love for God, will you reach out to others?
