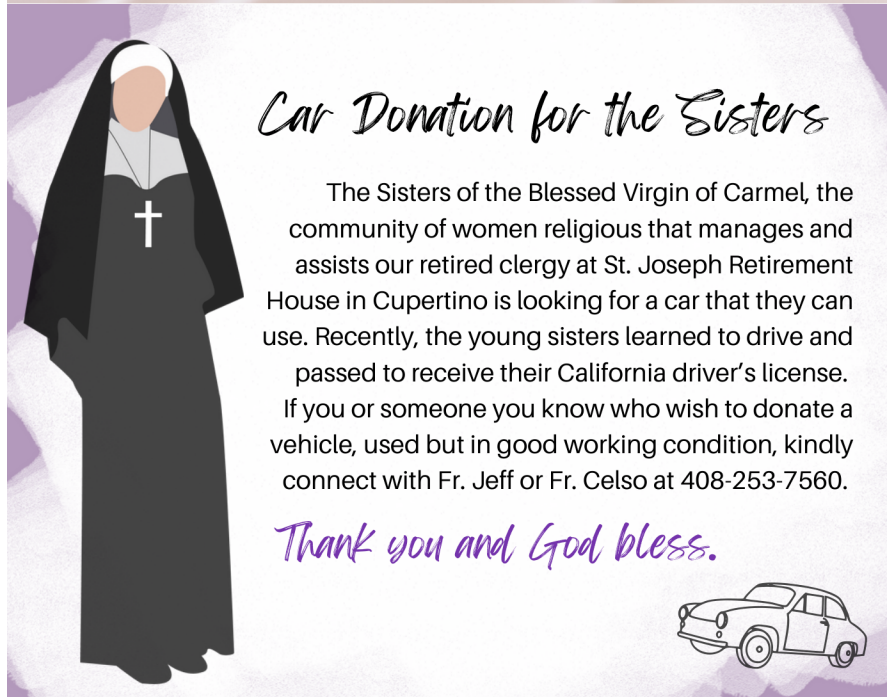

# From The Pastor's Desk

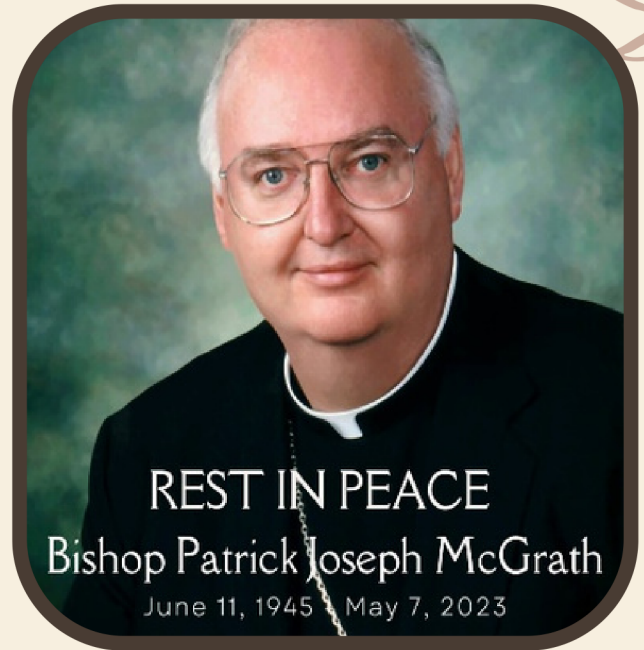


The Diocese of San Jose, including Queen of Apostles Parish, deeply mourns the passing of the Most Reverend Patrick Joseph McGrath, JCD, DD, the second bishop of the Diocese. His passing was a shock to many of us, since he had not been ill for long.

On Friday, April 21, he had suffered a fall at his home. He underwent surgery on Tuesday, April 25 to repair a spinal disk that he sustained from the fall. Unfortunately, he developed pneumonia during his convalescence from which he never recovered.

Bishop Oscar Cantú had asked for prayers for Bishop McGrath as he went into hospice care over the weekend. Sadly, Bishop McGrath died on Sunday, May 7, 2023. He was 77 years old.

Patrick Joseph McGrath was born June 11, 1945, in Dublin, Ireland, where he attended Catholic schools of the Sisters of the Holy Faith and the Marist Fathers. He entered Saint John Seminary, Waterford, Ireland in 1964 and was ordained to the priesthood in Waterford, June 7, 1970, for the Archdiocese of San Francisco.



In 1977, he earned his doctorate in canon law at the Pontifical Lateran University, Rome. In 1979, Bishop McGrath became Officialis of the Archdiocese of San Francisco. While serving as judicial vicar of the Archdiocese, he taught canon law classes at St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park. He was a very good canonist and a wonderful professor. He made us appreciate canon law as an important part of pastoral ministry of priests.

In 1986, Archbishop John Quinn appointed him rector and pastor of Saint Mary's Cathedral. In September 1987, he welcomed Pope John Paul II to the Cathedral during the first papal visit to the western United States.

Father McGrath was appointed auxiliary bishop of San Francisco and was ordained bishop on January 25, 1989. As auxiliary bishop, he served as Vicar for Clergy, Moderator of the Curia and Vicar for Parishes.

On June 30, 1998, he was named by Pope John Paul II to be Coadjutor to the Bishop of the Diocese of San Jose. He was formally received into the diocese at a Mass of Welcome, September 17, 1998. Upon the retirement of Bishop Pierre DuMaine on November 27, 1999, Bishop Patrick Joseph McGrath became the second Bishop of San Jose in California.

In recognition of his work and ministry, he was awarded an honorary doctorate in theology by Santa Clara University in 2001. He had worked with the University leaders and the larger community in Santa Clara Valley on issues such as immigration and separation of immigrant families, health care, education, unjust treatment of student DREAM seekers brought to the United States when they were children. He made sure that steps and protocols were in place to fight the scourge of abuse and sexual misconduct by clergy.

Bishop McGrath retired on May 1, 2019 and was succeeded by Bishop Oscar Cantú.

I had the good fortune of serving as Bishop McGrath's Episcopal Master of Ceremonies for twenty years, from 1999 to 2019, his whole term as Bishop of San Jose. He was very instrumental in my vocation to the priesthood and ordained me priest for the diocese on June 7, 2014.

Let us join one another in praying for the repose of his soul and the consolation of his family and everyone who mourn his passing. The schedule of services is printed on the next page and posted on diocesan websites (dsj.org).

May the soul of Bishop PJ and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

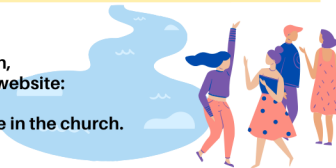
