HOLY FAMILIES

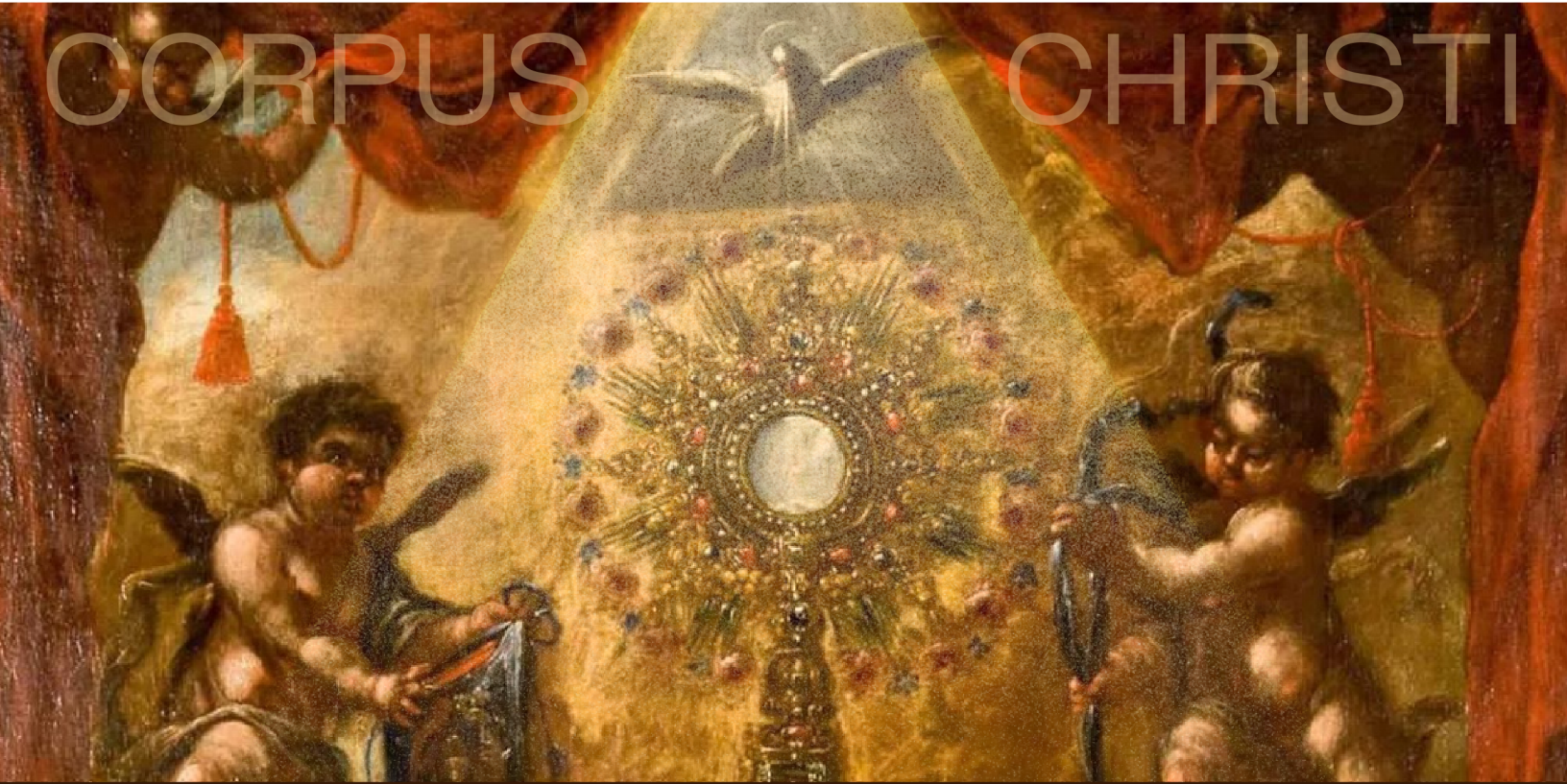

CORPUS CHRISTI



Jesus said, "I am the living bread. Whoever eats of this bread will live forever."
John 6: 51-52

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This day was once called Corpus Christi, which is Latin for the Body of Christ. The feast calls us to focus on the Body of Christ in two ways:

1. Present in the Eucharist and
2. Present in the Church.

We, as Catholic Christians, believe that at the consecration, the bread and wine are changed into the Real Presence of Christ. Do YOU believe by faith in the Real Presence of Christ?

Few studies show that only about 22% of Catholics in the United States believe in the Real Presence. The remaining either don't understand Church teachings or they believe that the bread and wine are symbols. Parishioners who attend mass frequently, though, are more likely to believe in the Real Presence.

Where do you stand?

Secondly, we believe that we, the Church, are the Body of Christ. Jesus himself came to dwell within us. When we receive Eucharist, the minister lifts it before us saying, "Body of Christ." And we respond, "Amen" which means, "Yes, I believe." Jesus' LIGHT and LOVE within us sends us out to be the Body of Christ in the world. We are called to bring JOY, LOVE, COMPASSION and MERCY to everyone we meet. As disciples of Christ, we each share our time, talents and treasure as we are able. We look to Mary, Our Mother, as the first disciple. She bore the Real Presence of Christ in her womb and shared him. Mary journeys with us always leading us to her Son. PRAY and CONSIDER: Might God be calling you to be a Eucharistic Minister at a mass that you attend? Or might you bring Eucharist (Jesus himself) to the Sick? Both are such privileges. St. Francis of Assisi said,

"It is in giving that we receive."

Corpus Christi Procession:

Today, many Catholic churches in the Diocese of San Jose will have processions around their church neighborhood. The priest holds high the monstrance with the consecrated Host for reverence by the parishioners who follow and by all who see.

Queen of Apostles will have ONE

Corpus Christi procession.

It will be immediately after the 5pm Mass on Saturday, June 10th and led by our pastor, Fr. Jeff Fernandez.
