From the Pastor's Desk



For the past three Sundays we have been celebrating great solemnities as a Church. The fifty days of Easter in which we are reminded of Christ Resurrection is God's great act of love to his only begotten Son and to us. The love of God the Father and the Son did not stop upon Christ Ascension into heaven. Jesus seated at the right hand of the Father continues to intercede for us. The love of the Father and the Son brought us the gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost so that we can continue to experience the love and unity of the Most Holy Trinity, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

God's love has been fully expressed to us through the gift of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist. And this love is remarkably expressed to us as we celebrate, the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

As we enter fully into the Ordinary Time of the church liturgical year the focus is our calling as disciple and how we need to respond to the faithful love of God in us. The gospel this Sunday reminds us that "the harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest. Then he summoned his twelve disciples....first, Simon called Peter, and his brother Andrew; James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip and Bartholomew, Thomas, and Matthew the tax collector; James, the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddeus; Simon from Cana, and Judas Iscariot who betrayed him."

The calling of the disciples by name is important to us as Christian disciples for God calls us also by name. And our calling compels us to bring the face and the name of Christ to the world.

The gospel ends by the instruction of Jesus to the twelve apostles and now to us, "Go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. As you go, make this proclamation:

'The kingdom of heaven is at hand...

Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give."

Sacred Meart of Jesus


