Dear clergy and staff of the Diocese of San José,

It is with deep sadness that I inform you about the passing of Maria de Jesus Cantú (Durón), mother of Bishop Oscar Cantú, who entered eternal life on Monday, September 18, 2023 in Houston, TX.



Maria de Jesus was born on January 11, 1934, in Villa Aldama, a small town on the outskirts of Monterrey, Nuevo Leon, Mexico. She is the third of six siblings, Josefina +, Jose +, Pedro + Alicia + and Mague. She married Ramiro Cantú + and together formed a beautiful family of eight children: Leticia, Ramiro, Luciano, Maria, Oscar, Nancy, Ricardo, and Juan.

Maria de Jesus, who was lovingly called Mary, was a pious woman and devoted to the Virgin of Guadalupe. She dedicated herself to the ministry of the Hispanic community at her parish, Holy Name Church in the near northside of Houston, Texas. Her husband, Ramiro, worked as a machinist. Together, they saw their children grow up and taught them with faith, hard work, and love. Maria led a very active and committed life in her parish, helping everyone who needed it. She and her husband belonged to the Christian Family Movement and celebrated family with great pride.

Maria dedicated her life to her eight children, many grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. She mentored countless young women who moved into the parish community. Her wisdom inspired anyone who asked her for advice and maintained a healthy sense of humor.

Her children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and extended family are infinitely grateful for your prayers and expressions of condolences. May Maria rest in peace with the Lord.

This Wednesday, September 27 th is the Feast Day of Saint Vincent de Paul. Born in France to peasant farmers, he dedicated his life to serving the poor. Vincent became an Occitan French Catholic priest. He was the founder of the Vincentian priests, the Daughters of Charity of Saint Vincent de Paul, and the Ladies of Charity – a group of lay women founded in 1617 who continue to respond to the needs of the poor. Our local branch in San Jose raises funds for tuition for Sacred Heart Nativity School.

Fr. Vincent was renowned for his *compassion, humility* and generosity. He was canonized in 1737 and is the *Patron Saint of all works of charity and volunteers.*

Queen of Apostles Saint Vincent de Paul Ministry (SVdP) assists people with our food pantry, gift cards for gas and food, and (after screening) with rent and household bills. We provide Thanksgiving food baskets and gift cards, and at Christmas, we have a special outreach to identified veterans' families with gift cards and specific requested gifts for the veteran parents and their children and teens.

How can YOU help SVdP at Queen of Apostles?

- Year-round, you may bring in non-perishable food and canned goods for our food pantry. Put them into our SVdP box in the Moorpark vestibule of our church.
- Every 5 th Sunday, SVdP has a special collection. The next collection will be Sunday, October 29. Make checks to Queen of Apostles, SVdP in memo line.
- Flyers will be coming out soon with the list of food items you may bring for our Thanksgiving Food Drive.
