





ST. THÉRÈSE OF LISEUX

Also known as: "Saint Theresa of the Child Jesus" and "The Little Flower"

1/2/1873 - 9/30/1897

Today, October 1 st, is the Feast Day of Saint Theresa of Lisieux. She is a beloved saint to many who are drawn to her "Little Way" – to do ordinary things with great love. The youngest of nine children, Saint Theresa was born in France. She and her four living sisters were Carmelite sisters. Many may not know that Theresa suffered from depression. She gave glory to God just by being her beautiful little self among the other flowers in God's garden. Theresa preferred to speak plainly to God and Mother Mary. Her autobiography, The Story of a Soul, was published a year after her death.

Theresa died at the young age of 24 from tuberculosis. She was beatified on May 17, 1925 by Pope Pius XI and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1997. Saint Theresa is the Patron Saint of florists and gardeners, the sick (especially tuberculosis) priests and foreign missions. During a novena to Saint Theresa, if your prayer is answered, she will 'send' you a white rose.


