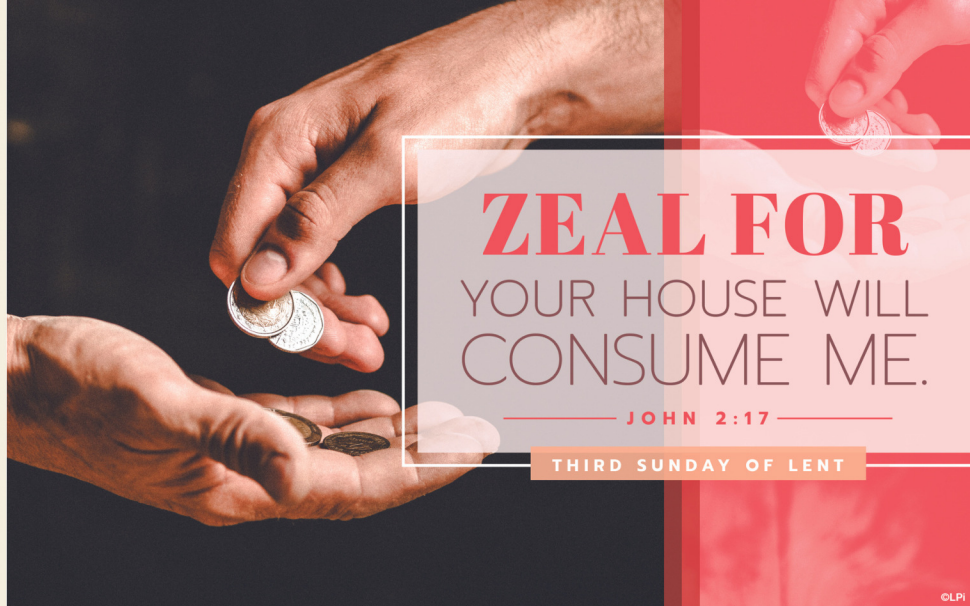

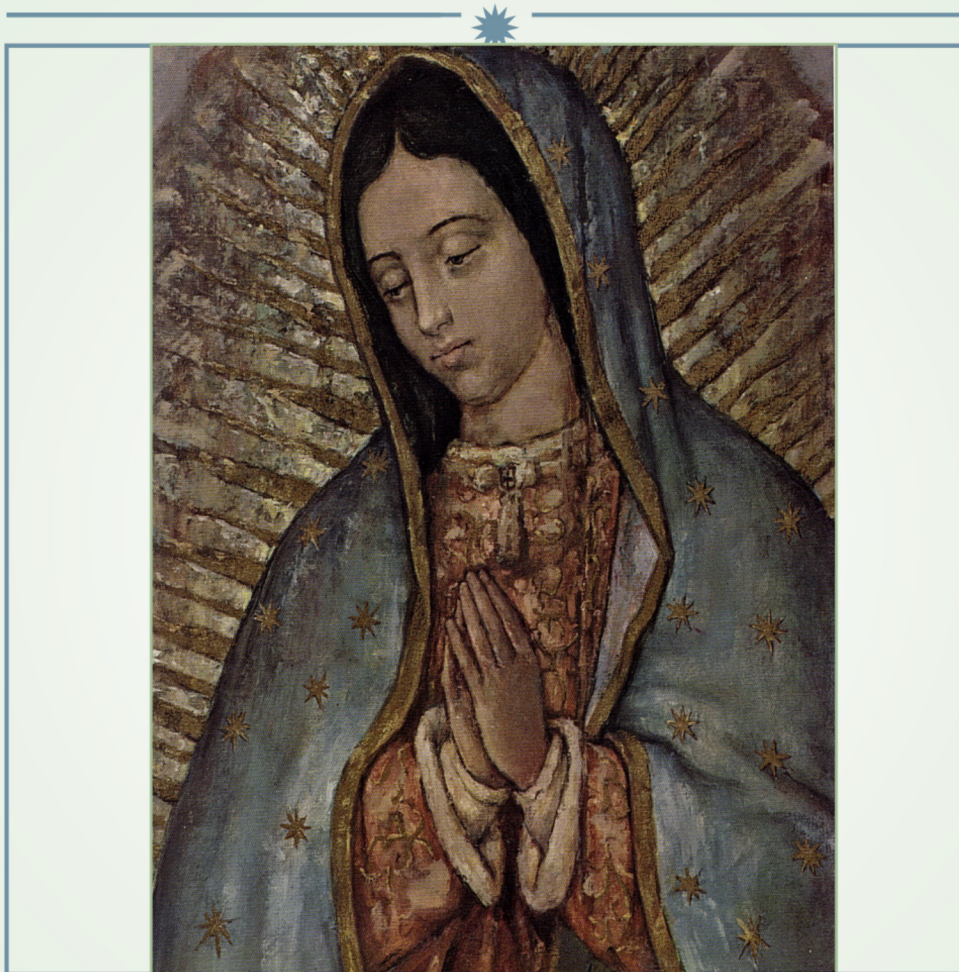


In receiving the Eucharist each Sunday,
