LENT BEGINS THIS WEEK - with Mass and Distribution of Ashes at St. Therese at 8:30 AM, and at St. Boniface at 7:00 PM. St. Therese Lectors are Leo and Mary Wiederholt, and Eucharistic Ministers are Peg and Galen Wichman and Marlene Laird. At St. Boniface, Lectors are Michelle Rockers and Tony Mersman; Eucharistic Ministers are Loretta Sobba, Ora Lee O'Brien, and Joan Rockers; and Servers are Katie and Nick Lybarger and Taryn Morrow. Fasting and Abstinence Regulations: Catholics who are 18 and not yet 60 years old are asked to observe Fast Days. All Catholics over the age of 14 are required to observe Days of Abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are Days of Abstinence (though this year, we have been given a dispensation from this requirement for the celebration of St. Patrick's Feast Day on March 17th!). Days of Fasting AND Abstinence are Ash Wednesday, March 1st, and Good Friday, April 14th. Fasting means eating only one full meal, and two smaller meals during the day as required for proper nourishment, with no eating between meals. Abstinence means not eating any meat or meat products. You will also find many more suggestions for fasting and abstinence contained in the Rice Bowl kits that are available this weekend. I would ask that EVERY family take a Rice Bowl Kit home, and use it faithfully during Lent. Collection bins will be available in both churches on Palm Sunday weekend and throughout Holy Week. Daily Reflections for Lent - Not by Bread Alone books are also available at both churches. There are enough for one copy per family - so please do take one home and share it among your family members. The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available at all parishes throughout the Archdiocese on Wednesday evenings, from 6 - 7 PM. Here at St. Boniface and St. Therese - I will be available at the Priory during that time period. Please just come to the front door of the Priory and ring the bell. Reconciliation is also available on Saturday afternoons from 3 - 3:45 PM in the Sacristy at St. Boniface. There are two Lenten Reflection programs available through our website: The Best Lent Ever, based on the Dynamic Catholic book you were given at Christmas: and another by Bishop Robert Baron.
