After March 1st, you can request additional weekend Masses.** Please keep in mind that Monday, Friday, and Sunday Masses are at St. Boniface; and Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday Masses are at St. Therese. Wednesday is the day the Mass is reserved for the intentions of all parishioners. **Please know how grateful I am for all who follow these guidelines!**

Heads Up! - the Washrooms at St. Boniface will be renovated beginning this Monday, January 11th. The work is scheduled to take three work weeks, thereby closing the washrooms for two weekends. A Porta-Potty will be available outdoors during this project. For those who participate at morning Masses on Mondays and Fridays, please enter the daily chapel (Sacristy) through the main entrance of the church.
