Our Communal Reconciliation Service, with the opportunity for individual Confessions, will be on Palm Sunday evening, March 28th at 5 PM. There are several links on our website that offer suggestions for a fruitful Lenten observance - take a look and use any or all of these as we journey through these Forty Days! Under the **LENT** link, be sure to check out the Carmel Prays offering! **Lenten Abstinence** - Catholics between the ages of 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from meat on all the Fridays of Lent. Abstinence forbids the use of meat.
