

Our Communal Reconciliation Service, with the opportunity for individual Confessions, will be on Palm Sunday evening, March 28th at 5 PM. Confessions at Holy Angels will be available on next Sunday, March 21st, at 11 AM.** There are several links on our website that offer suggestions for a fruitful Lenten observance - take a look and use any or all of these as we journey through these Forty Days! Under the **LENT** link, be sure to check out the Carmel Prays offering! **Lenten Abstinence** - Catholics between the ages of 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from meat on all the Fridays of Lent. Abstinence forbids the use of meat.

We will continue to distribute Holy Communion as we have since we reopened. Please remember to exit the churches in a manner that social distancing protocols are being adhered to.
