Preparing for the World Synod of Bishops - begun in 2021, and moving toward the culminating Synod in 2023, Pope Francis has asked that all members of the church have an opportunity to participate in the process of synodality - where everyone is invited to speak and be heard regarding key aspects of our faith and how our faith is lived in the world today. Locally, in our Archdiocese, there will be a process of input, whereby our local faith communities can funnel our reflections and concerns into the process. Beginning this weekend, a packet of 10 groupings of questions and concerns will be available for each person or family to take home with them as an initial step in this process. I'd like to ask everyone to take a copy home with you, look it over, and prayerfully begin to formulate your input. There is also a prayer card in each missalette, as well as extras to take with you, which we will begin saying at the end of all Masses until the Synod meets in 2023 and while it is going on in Rome. The theme of the Synod is: COMMUNION:

**PARTICIPATION; MISSION** and the underlying question that is being asked of all of us is: What is the Holy Spirit saying to our church today? In the not too distant future, various groupings of people from our parishes will be called together where our thoughts, questions, and reflections may be shared, and then forwarded on to the Archdiocese for inclusion in the process as it is brought to fulfillment in Rome. **This is a "once in a lifetime" opportunity** for all Catholics

throughout the world to speak up, to listen, to be heard, and to celebrate who we <u>ALL</u> are as members of the Body of Christ. <u>PLEASE</u> participate at our local level to the best of your ability in this exciting process! Thanks!

2022 Mass Calendars - are now available. January is already full but the rest of the year is fairly wide open. Please recall that the normal stipend for a Mass is \$10.00, and that the stipends go to the two parishes (as you can see in this weekend's Bulletin). If you want to reserve a particular date, it is best to let me know that as soon as possible - preferably in writing! - by putting your request and stipend in an envelope in the regular collection, mailing it to me, or handing it to me at your convenience. Until March 1st, you may only request up to 3 Masses on a Saturday evening at St. Therese or Sunday morning at St. Boniface. After March 1st, this limit will be lifted. All checks should be made out to St. Boniface Stipend Account or St. Therese Stipend Account. Thanks for your cooperation with this!
