2016 Annual Catholic Appeal

What Prayer Is

Our *Family Faith Formation* home lesson topic this week is: "What Prayer Is," covered in Questions 262 -265 of *The Apostolate's Family Catechism*. Home lesson packets are available on the parish website.

By-Heart Catechism

262. What is prayer? Prayer is the lifting of our minds and hearts to God. We lift our minds and hearts to God to praise His goodness, thank Him for His kindness, acknowledge our sins, plead for pardon, ask His aid for our Salvation, and give glory to Him.

263. What is mental or interior prayer? Mental or interior prayer begins with a serious consideration of the truths of the Faith, with a view to their practical application to our daily lives. During mental prayer, you grow in the knowledge of your faith and acquire principles of right living by applying yourself to prolonged reflection on some doctrine of the Church or teaching of our Savior.

264. Why is prayer necessary? Prayer is necessary because (1) God has commanded us to pray, and (2) it is an unconditional means of obtaining grace. The need for prayer is rooted in man's very nature as a creature of God who receives gifts from His generosity.

Peace at the Park

St. Mary of the Rosary in Chewelah, along with the UCC and the Mormon communities in Chewelah, is hosting an ecumenical and community event called "Peace at the Park," to be held at Chewelah City Park Center Stage on Sunday, April 3 (Divine Mercy Sunday) from Noon to 1:30 PM

This event is an ecumenical effort in response to the increasing outbreaks of violence and terror in recent months. There is a general sense that peace means nothing more than absence of war, and we should be happy with absence of war and simply settle with that. But true peace, the peace of Christ, is not merely the absence of conflict but the presence and abundance of justice, charity, mercy, and all that Christ offers us, all that humans need for our human flourishing as we continue our pilgrim's progress toward God. Whatever we need in this life to get to God, Heaven, and the life heareafter — *that* is what makes for *true* peace.

Because "Peace at the Park" is ecumenical in spirit, we sincerely hope and fully expect to have a sizeable Catholic contingent present at this event. Flyers on parish bulletin boards outline details regarding this event: religious and civic leaders offering short addresses; music and displays of art; poetry composed in honor of peace; and lunch is being provided by St. Mary of the Rosary parishioner Ed Kaup. The event will be held at the Center Stage in Chewelah City Park; in case of rain, the event will be held at the Chewelah Civic Center.

Those of our parishioners who are particularly interested in promoting ecumenism among area churches are invited to speak with Fr. Jeff; we are on the look-out for parishioners who will help him strengthen ties with our brothers and sisters in Christ throughout the Chewelah Valley area. As for everybody: please do consider attending "Peace at the Park" in support of local peace efforts and our ecumenical efforts as Catholics in our area.
