First Friday Devotion in June

Friday, June 3, is the first Friday in June. It is also the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Fr. Jeff is on retreat that week, which means there will be **no Mass or Holy Hour at St. Mary of the Rosary** on June 3 for the First Friday devotion.

However, Fr. Victor Blazovich, pastor in Newport, is celebrating Mass in Springdale for Sacred Heart's patronal feast at 6:00 PM. Everyone participating in the First Friday devotion is invited to attend that Mass with Fr. Vic and the Sacred Heart parishioners. This is particularly relevant because First Friday devotions are related to devotion to the Sacred Heart of Christ. The devotion dates back to the last decades of the 17th century, when Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary and spoke to her of His Sacred Heart. Among the promises Our Lord revealed to St. Margaret Mary, the 12th specifically referenced practices for Fridays.

In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.

Saint of the Week

Our first Saint of the Week this summer is one of the twelve Apostles: one of the two Saint James. This one is commonly regarded as Saint James the Greater. He is the brother of Saint John (both of them the "Sons of Zebedee" and "Sons of Thunder"). Together with John and Peter, James the Greater was one of the favored three who had the privilege of witnessing the Transfiguration, the raising to life of the daughter of Jairus, and the agony in the garden of Gethsemane. Like all of the Apostles, as the Gospel narrates, James struggled early on with his faith and understanding of the Lord and His mission; but again, like all of the Apostles, his faith very much came alive after the Lord's Ascension and the descent of the Holy Spirit upon them at that first Christian Pentecost. James holds the honor of being the first of the apostles to be martyred, as we find in the Acts of the Apostles: "About that time, King Herod laid hands upon some members of the Church to harm them. He had James, the brother of John, killed by the sword, and when he saw that this was pleasing to the Jews, he proceeded to arrest Peter also." (Acts 12:1-3a)

(Incidentally, the other Saint James, Saint James the Lesser, is the "brother" – a generic familial term that includes cousin – of Jesus Himself. Saint James the Lesser was the first bishop of Jerusalem, as we find in the Acts of the Apostles, and also the author of the Epistle of Saint James in the New Testament.)

Saint James the Greater is widely revered in Spain, among other places. There is a very famous church in Spain called "Santiago," which is Spanish for "Saint James." The world-famous *via compestella* is a pilgrimage route that begins in one of several locations in France, crosses the Pyrenee Mountains at the French-Spanish border, and then proceeds along northern Spain toward the Atlantic Ocean, where Santiago is located. Among the countless people who have made this pilgrimage in recent times are Spokane priest Msgr. Kevin Codd (who has written a book about his experience), and this summer, our own Brenda St. John is going to make this pilgrimage. We pray for her safety, her success, and her rejuvenation of spirit!
