### Fr. Mike's Corner for Feb. 28th.



In Genesis 22, today's first reading, God is telling us through the events that he will sacrifice His only Son to redeem us.

Abraham prefigures God the Father, Isaac prefigures Our Lord who carries the cross up Mt Moriah and gives his life for us as the Lamb of Sacrifice provided by God. As in Exodus 12, Our Lord is a lamb without blemish nor broken bones. He is the sinless one who brought for you and I eternal life. Do we act as Abraham and Moses or do we act like many of the Jews did on the way out of Egypt and say no to Him?


