Fr. Mike's Corner



Lent. It's almost half over. What have you done? What have I done? One idea is if you don't pray on a regular basis start doing so. Perhaps ten minutes of meditation might help. Prayer and meditation help deepen our relationship with God. If you

don't pray, you're "toast." That's the advice I was given even as a lay person.

Virtue is also to be considered. Charity isn't just being giving with material things but with time and includes a willingness to forgive and let go of grudges. If you don't forgive, don't bother asking God to forgive you. He warns you that he won't. Forgiving others is a mandatory part of the price we pay if we want to get into heaven. Piety is worshipping God in the way He wants us to. Wisdom is also important because it helps us see things as God does.

Humility is the last thing I'll mention. A humble person follows Christ's example and keeps his/her heart open to God's grace. A proud person imitates the devil very well. That was Lucifer's sin and it turned him into the devil because it caused him to reject God. It's a reminder to be humble.

St Joseph



St. Joseph is the foster father of Jesus and guardian of the Holy Family. He's also the patron of workers and terror of demons. He's not as powerful as his wife, the Blessed Virgin, but don't mess with him!

St. Joseph has no actual words mentioned in scripture - just the example of his obedience to God when he is instructed to take in Our Lady, protect her on the journey to Egypt and back, and to move to Nazareth. According to one of the old legends there were several suitors for Our Lady, but his staff flowered indicating that he was to be her husband. This is why St. Joseph is often portrayed with a staff with a flower on it.

St. Joseph is also the example of fathers. So fathers, ask for his intercession. He took responsibility for caring for Mary and Our Lord, stood up when needed to worldly threats and of course, provided for the Holy Family by his labor. The church holds him up as an example of fatherhood for us to follow.

Welcome to our Parish Community!




