A MESSAGE FROM FATHER

A Rock and a Hard Place!



In today's Gospel, Matthew 22:15-22, the Pharisees planned to trap Jesus in posing a difficult question. It is one of those questions, that if you answer "yes" or "no," you are accused.

The Pharisees address Jesus by saying to him that He is a truthful man and not concerned about the opinion of others. Then, comes the attack! They ask Him, "Is it lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar or not?" The Roman Empire occupied the Holy Land. They were enemies of the Jews. If Jesus answers "Yes," He will be accused of siding with the enemy and get in trouble with the Jews! If Jesus answers "No," He would be committing a crime by speaking against the Roman Empire. The Pharisees must have been quite pleased with their clever tactics. They thought they had Jesus in a trap He could not avoid. The Pharisees are no match for the Divine Wisdom of our Lord. He responds with a question. "Whose inscription is on this coin?" The Pharisees said it was Caesar's. Jesus tells them to pay to Caesar what is his, but to pay to God what is God's. The Pharisees failed in their attempt again!

The Pharisees focus on how they can get Jesus in trouble and have him killed. They do not sincerely seek to learn what He has to teach them. Isn't that a trap we can also fall into? We can be so focused on non-issues and miss the message and wisdom of it completely. We need Jesus Christ to lead us and guide us.

We may also feel like we are between a rock and a hard place at times. With the General Election just over 2 weeks away, it might be good to take some time to reflect on a document called "Your Faith, Your Vote" prepared by the North Dakota Catholic Conference. You can check it out online at <http://www.yourfaithyourvote.org/> It also has statements by our Bishop and the Bishop of Bismarck. Let our faith be our guide!
