Greetings Holy Cross Parishioners,

My name is Earl Miranda and I am the Holy Cross representative on the St. John Paul 2 Catholic Schools Advisory Council. JP2 Catholic Schools serve the FM area with three elementary schools, Holy Spirit, Nativity, and Trinity, Sullivan Middle School and Shanley High School. Funding sources for our Catholic schools include tuition, parish and diocesan support, as well as generous donors. Thank you for your support.

My wife Rebecca and I have been blessed with 8 children. Three have graduated from Shanley (classes of 2015, 2017 and 2020), two are at Sheyenne High School (Senior and Freshman), one is at Sullivan (6th grade) and two are at Trinity (4th grade and pre-K). As reflected in my family, Catholic Schools are not for every child. However, attending a Catholic School is rewarding for many families and can be within everyone's budget.

Currently elementary school tuition is \$3,780 and high school is \$6,605. For the 2020-2021 academic school year, JP2 awarded \$665,000 in tuition assistance.


