BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE



7 members of the Building Committee served on an Interview Committee to select a professional fund-raising firm to help us raise money for our new Church. They've worked hard with a few meetings to prepare for our 8 hour interview session a week ago Saturday. We

interviewed three firms. All three were impressive. It was a challenge for us to make a final selection. We decided to ask GIG (Guidance in Giving) of Bayport, NY to help us. Details have to be worked out so it's not final yet. Once that is complete, we will arrange a start date for their work.

The Professional Team (architects, Catholic architect, liturgical consultant, Earl Wilhelm) continue to meet to work on our plans for the church and additional office space. We hope to have some preliminary (but not final) plans ready to present to our parishioners.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

The Stations of the Cross began as the practice of pious pilgrims to Jerusalem who would retrace the final journey of Jesus Christ to Calvary.

Later, for the many who wanted to pass along the same route, but could not make the trip to Jerusalem, a practice developed that eventually took the form of the fourteen stations currently found in almost every church.

Holy Cross will offer the Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 7:00 pm. Everyone is welcome to join. (February 26th, March 5th, 12th, 19th & 26th)




