A Message from Father



"I am the True Vine"

What is the value of a withered branch? It's dried up, lying on the ground and needs to be removed. Often, it's burned or just thrown away. Jesus illustrates how important it is for us to be connected to Him. Jesus established our Church. He knows we need to be connected. Being off on our own doesn't work.

In Matthew 18.20, Jesus says, "For where two or three come together in My name, I am there with them." There are some who are convinced that they don't need "organized religion." This is contrary to what Jesus tells us to do. We are to be one family. We are to live our faith in the Church. Otherwise, we are like a withered branch. We cannot bear fruit apart from Him.

The dispensation for the faithful to "attend Church" virtually because of the pandemic has ended. If we are physically able, we are called to attend Church in person. We cannot receive the Body and Blood of Christ remotely. We gather at Christ's altar to celebrate the Eucharist. We are so blessed to receive the greatest gift Jesus offers us! We receive Him!

We remain united to Jesus Christ in three ways: a) gathering in His Name; b) listening to His Word; c) receiving the Body and Blood of Christ. So, if we want to find Christ, we find Him in the Church He gave to us. Otherwise, we don't find Him at all.

<u>Accompanist</u> — The accompanist is responsible to provide accompaniment for the hymns and acclamations during the Mass. Accompaniment skills are required, and knowledge of the Catholic Mass is preferred. *This is a paid position*.

<u>Cantor (Song Leader)</u> - The Cantor is both a singer and leader of the congregational song. The Cantor has the

responsibility for any songs or hymns that require solo passages, leading the assembly, and inviting the assembly in hymns and acclamations used throughout Mass. The requirements to be a successful Cantor include a strong singing voice, ability to encourage the people to join in the songs and dedication to the ministry of music. Being a Cantor does not require being in any of the choirs. This ministry is open to high school/adult singers.


