A MESSAGE FROM FATHER



It is Holy Week!

This week is the most important week of the Church year! Jesus was born into the world to save us. He died for us. He took on the punishment for our sins. **We don't deserve to be forgiven. He forgives us!**

For us, as we journey in faith, we ask for forgiveness and seek to follow the example of Christ. We also imitate the example of Christ and forgive others; even though they may not deserve to be forgiven.

How often have we heard in the Scriptures: "...forgive and you will be forgiven?" We are given the strength to forgive. Christ gives us what we need to follow Him.

This is the holiest of weeks. Today, we read the Passion and Death of Our Lord Jesus Christ as we welcome Him to Jerusalem with palm branches.

On Holy Thursday, we remember the Last Supper when Christ instituted the Holy Eucharist. He gives us His very self—His Body and Blood! When we come to communion, we receive the actual Body and Blood of Christ.

On Good Friday, we journey with Christ as He carries His Cross. We read the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ. We venerate the Cross. We pray for the needs of the Church and the world. We receive the Body of Christ.

The Easter Vigil is the most important liturgy of the entire Church Year. We begin the Vigil in darkness as **we await the Light of Christ. Without Christ, our world is dark, confused and lost. It's a powerful experience to welcome Christ's light into the darkened Church. We listen to Scripture Readings that tell the story of salvation.** We renew our Baptismal Vows. We welcome the newly Baptized and Confirmed into our community of faith. Christ is Risen!

Easter Sunday is filled with the joy of new life. Christ destroyed sin and death. We have been freed from all that holds us back.

It's the holiest of weeks, but also the most inspiring and beautiful of weeks as we celebrate New Life in Christ!

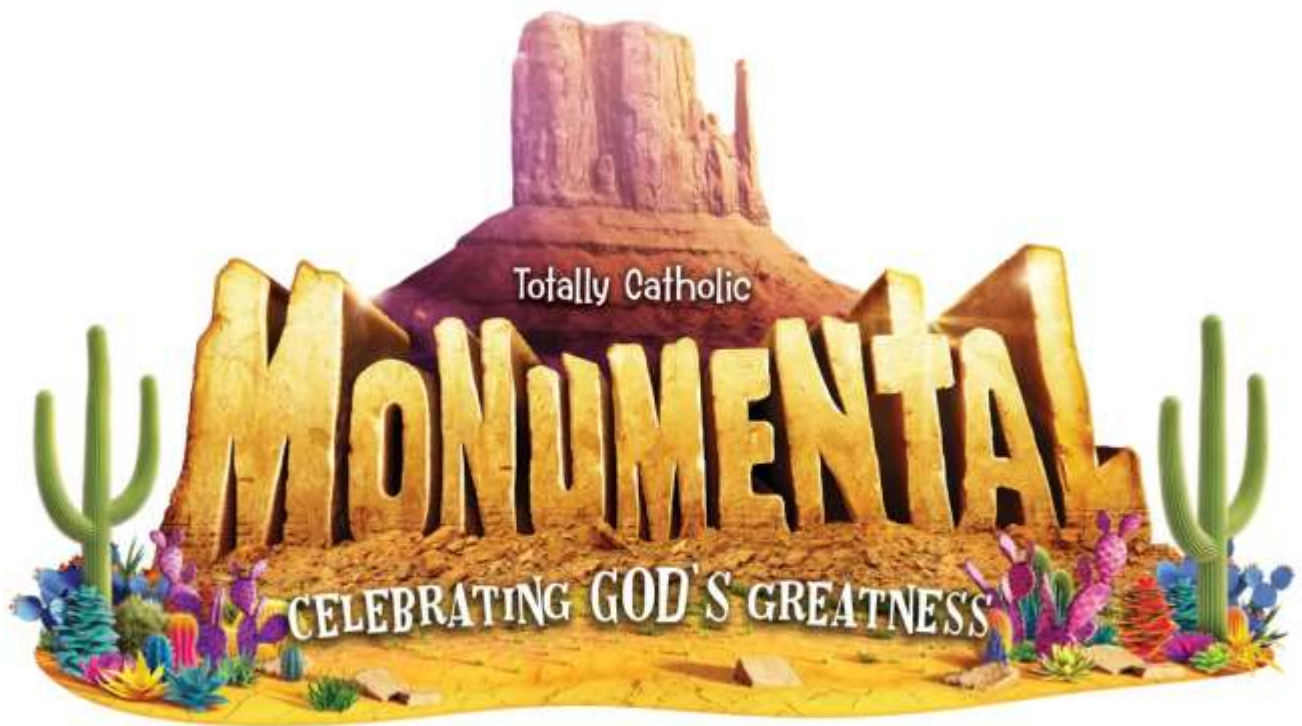
