A Message from Father



Who Chose the Better Part?

We can relate to the story in today's Gospel (Luke 10.38-42). Jesus is at the home of Martha and Mary. Martha is busy serving a meal for Jesus and others. Where was Mary? She was sitting at Jesus' feet. How frustrating! Martha was doing all the work!

Yes, we can identify with Martha. Where is everyone? Why aren't they helping out? Here's what happens in today's Gospel:

"Martha, burdened with much serving, came to him and said,

"Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me by myself to do the serving? Tell her to help me." The Lord said to her in reply, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her."

Imagine how Martha reacted. She was probably surprised and maybe still a bit upset. Mary chose the better part! Jesus invites us to choose the better part. He invites us to sit at His feet and listen to Him. We are to spend time with Him; even "waste" time with Him.

In today's world, people seem to be so busy with so much stuff. It is easy to be distracted and place the importance of time and energy in things that are not as important as spouses, family and friends. Sometimes husbands and wives drift apart by putting so much time and energy on their children.

Prayer helps us to be more centered in choosing what is more important in life. Over the years, I've heard people reflect about their deceased parents, "I should have spent more time with them." "Why didn't I just let some things go and be attentive to my parents and their needs?"

Mary chose the better part. Let us spend time with Jesus Christ. Let us choose the better part.
