A Message from Father



"Were not our hearts burning within us?"

Today's Gospel passage (Luke 24.13-15) is a fascinating story about Jesus joining two of His disciples as they were walking on the road from Jerusalem to Emmaus. They did not recognize Him!

The disciples were saddened because they told the person that joined them on the walk about what happened to Jesus Christ and how He suffered, was crucified and buried. They told "the stranger" that they had hoped that Jesus would be the one to redeem Israel.

Jesus recounted with them references about Himself in the Scriptures beginning with Moses and all the prophets. They still did not "see" Him.

Then the two disciples invited Jesus to stay with them because it was late in the day. He accepted their invitation. As they sat at the table, Jesus broke bread, gave thanks and gave it to them. The disciples finally recognized Jesus in the Breaking of the Bread!

Jesus did not stay with them. The two disciples hurried back to Jerusalem to tell the others what they experienced. They shared how their hearts were burning inside of them as Jesus interpreted the Scriptures.

As we come to Mass, let us also come to recognize Jesus more and more. We are grateful for what was given to us at Easter! Let us also share this Good News with others as the disciples did.


