I AM the Good Shepherd

Today is the Fourth Sunday of Easter. Every year during the Easter Season, we devote this Fourth Sunday to the Good Shepherd.

It's interesting that Jesus called Himself "The Good Shepherd." Why? The job of a shepherd is never ending. It's a 24/7 type of job. A good shepherd doesn't just put his/her time in and works for a paycheck. It is a deep commitment to care for the sheep. Sheep, by the way, need a lot of care. They can't figure things out on their own like other farm animals. They need a lot of help! But so do we, too!

So what are the qualities of a good shepherd?

1. A good shepherd is a totally committed person that lives for the flock day after day, week after week, month after month. It's not just another job.
2. A good shepherd is a deeply caring person. A shepherd's satisfaction is the well-being of the flock. When the flock is doing well, the shepherd is doing well.
3. A good shepherd is courageous. When the flock is in danger, the good shepherd is there to protect the sheep, not counting the cost.

Jesus is there for us to care for us. He provides for our needs. The Scriptures reminds us, about 365 times, not to fear. Be not afraid! Jesus takes care of us!

How about us? We are to serve Christ, the Good Shepherd by helping others. That means that we model ourselves after Christ, whose work is never ending, without reservation and courageous. We are called to shepherd others.
