A MESSAGE FROM FATHER



Congratulations, High School Graduates!

We are honoring our high school graduates today at the 9:00 AM Mass. You are in our thoughts and prayers during this milestone in your lives! May God bless you now and always!

Fr Seitz left last Wednesday for a few days of vacation before his new assignment. As you know, he has been appointed to be Bishop's Secretary. But he will also be working on a degree in Canon Law at Catholic University, Washington, DC beginning on May 30th. When he returns from his vacation on May 22nd, he will have three days to pack, move to the Bishop's House before he drives to Washington, DC. He will spend part of the summer attending classes at Catholic U. Then he will return to Fargo to continue his studies online and serve as Bishop

Folda's secretary.

We are grateful for his priestly ministry here at Holy Cross. We regret that we were not able to have some kind of going away gathering for him. The new assignment and beginning his studies shortened his time at Holy Cross.

The Solemnity of the Ascension: Being Left Behind

As we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord, I think of how the disciples felt when Jesus ascended into heaven. They must have been confused and scared. I wonder if they were unsure of what they should do next. However, in today's Gospel (Matthew 28.16-20), as Jesus sends them forth, He told them that He would be with them always, even to the end of the age!

Speaking of being left behind, I am also thinking about parents who have a son or daughter graduating from high school next week. They know how this life-changing event means that their son or daughter will be leaving home for school, military service or other ventures. Parents must be thinking: Will those kids be okay? Yes, they have a lot to learn. We pray and entrust them to the Lord.

As Jesus sent the disciples forth, He also probably thought that they had a lot to learn, too. But He said He would be with them. He would guide them. He sent them the Holy Spirit to accomplish what the disciples could not do on their own.

We may feel left behind at times. It's important for us to remember that Jesus is with us always! He told us that! That is comforting, especially when we worry or are discouraged. We are not left behind. He takes care of us. He takes care of our children.

Building Update

As I mentioned before, we've had about seven different crews working on our church and office addition project. Much of the work these past several months were not very visible from the street.

But now, much work is being done on the office addition. Wiring, plumbing has been installed. Sheetrock is going up. The office addition may be ready in June.

Some cement work has been done in the church area. Pouring the floor of the gathering space is completed.. Duct work on the main church is being done.

Because of the spring melt and recent rains, some heavy equipment is not able to be onsite for projects such as pouring the floor for the new church. That particular project may take several days to complete or maybe up to two weeks.
