A MESSAGE FROM FATHER



Take Up Your Cross and Follow Me!

In today's Gospel (Matthew 16.21-27), Jesus makes it very clear what we must do to follow Him.

"Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross and follow me."

Today's Scripture readings show us three important points for us as we live our faith.

1. The cross will always be a part of life. We can't avoid it. It's never far away from us. Even Jesus was not spared the cross!
2. When it comes to crosses in our lives, we have a choice to either accept it or reject it.
3. Jesus promises us that if we pick up our cross and follow in His footsteps, He will lead us to everlasting life.

When we pick up our crosses, it can become a blessing that leads us to greater things. I remember the devastating 1997 flood that destroyed almost the entire city of Grand Forks. When I was transferred to Grand Forks in 2002, I was surprised to find people saying, "The flood was tragic, painful and destructive. But in a way, it made our city a better place! So many improvements and upgrades were a result of this tragedy."

This is the Good News of Jesus Christ! When we carry the heavy burden of the cross, we have a choice to make. When we embrace the cross, Jesus will lead us to everlasting life!

Labor Day Weekend

We dedicate this weekend to our work force, those who labor. So often, when I see our construction workers erecting steel in subzero weather conditions, or workers installing rafters or laying brick in the intense heat of summer, I pray for them. It's exciting to see the progress of our new church.

Let us be grateful for all who work, who labor to provide for what we need. Let us pray for them as we observe Labor Day.

What do these roles do??



Accompanist – The accompanist is responsible to provide accompaniment for the hymns and acclamations during the Mass. Accompaniment skills are required, and knowledge of the Catholic Mass is preferred. *This is a paid position.*

Cantor (Song Leader) - The Cantor is both a singer and leader of the congregational song. The Cantor has the responsibility for any songs or hymns that require solo passages, leading the assembly, and inviting the assembly in hymns and acclamations used throughout Mass. The requirements to be a successful Cantor include a strong singing voice, ability to encourage the people to join in the songs and dedication to the ministry of music. Being a Cantor does not require being in any of the choirs. This ministry is open to high school/adult singers.
