## A MESSAGE FROM FATHER



### **Confrontation**

We all want to get along. We don't want to get people worked up. We do not want to face rejection or ridicule. We "choose our battles." However, at times, we need to tell others what they need to hear. This can be uncomfortable.

In today's Gospel (Matthew 18.15-20), Jesus instructs His disciples how to confront others. He says, "If your brother sins against you, tell him his fault between you and him alone." We are tempted to tell others about a transgression before going directly to the person who committed an offense. Sometimes, we never approach the person who committed the offense.

Jesus continues by saying that if that doesn't work, ask others to join you so that facts may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.

If that doesn't work, go to the Church.

When we confront, we must do it in a sincere, kind way. A few years ago, I was visiting with a police officer about his role as a supervisor of other officers. He was taught to confront an officer with this "formula:" Affirm, Confront, Affirm. I thought it was an excellent piece of advice. I use this "formula" as a great tool when I need to challenge others.

How often do we find ourselves in a situation where criticism and attacks are part of the confrontation? We are to correct people as an act of love and concern. I realize this doesn't always produce the results we'd like.

Speaking of criticism, I'd like to share what we priests learned at one of our annual continuing education workshops. The speaker (can't remember who it was) told us that for every time we criticize a person, we should compliment them four times!!! That's a lot! The point is that often, the only feedback we may give to another person is negative. That turns people off. People who only receive negative feedback will tune us out. We should also give positive feedback, too.

I was reading about some parents' methods of correcting their children: a mother who holds her child's hand or places her arm around her child when she corrects her. Or another mother who finds it difficult to correct a teenage son. She takes him to dinner to discuss serious matters.

Speaking out needs to be handled tactfully and delicately. Jesus Christ models this for us. Let us pray for His guidance.

### **Building Update**

Information from our August 30th Construction meeting:

Windows are being installed in the office addition. When completed, the remaining work can be done – such as flooring, installing the ceiling, and trim work.

Faith Formation classes begin on September 20th. We hope we will be able to use the new space for classes. At this time, we have 17 classrooms available. We need a total of 22 classrooms!

*What do these roles do??*



Accompanist – The accompanist is responsible to provide accompaniment for the hymns and acclamations during the Mass. Accompaniment skills are required, and knowledge of the Catholic Mass is preferred. *This is a paid position.*
