#### A Message from Father



Forgiveness is Twice Blessed!

Who said that? William Shakespeare! Really? First of all, the person who forgives is blessed. Secondly, the person who is forgiven is also blessed.

Have you heard someone say to you, "I will never forgive that person." Or, maybe you've had that thought yourself?

"Someone who has never forgiven an enemy has missed one of the most beautiful experiences in life." (Author John Lavater).

How can we forgive? What do we do when we can't forgive someone? The first step is to change the perception of the person that we cannot forgive. View that person as one created by God in His image. Think about the pain, struggles, challenges in life that person faces. When we see that person in a new light, it makes it possible to forgive.

If we are to forgive our enemies, we must try to see them as Jesus sees them: not as horrible people; but as frightened, hurt, damaged people who have lost their way.

In today's Gospel (Matthew 18.21-35), Peter asks Jesus how many times must he forgive his brother. Seven times? Jesus says, "I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times." The end of today's Gospel passage, Jesus says, "Should you not have pity on your fellow servants, as I had pity on you? ... So will my heavenly Father do to you, unless each of you forgives your brother from your heart."

In His darkest hour, as Jesus hung on the Cross, His prayer was "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing.." (Luke 23.34). The crowd was making fun of Him and insulting Him. They did not ask for forgiveness. Jesus forgave them.

Jesus would not ask us to do something that is impossible. With Christ, all things are possible.

Forgiveness: We must do the same as Jesus did on the Cross.

#### Church and Office Addition Building Update

Just to let you know that the deadline for submitting articles for the bulletin is on Tuesdays. Our weekly construction meetings are on Wednesdays. So the updates are over a week old by the time they are published in the bulletin.

Notes from our September 6th Weekly Construction Meeting

The office windows are installed. Painters will do touch-ups on the walls on September 8th.

The boards covering the rafters of the church are the ceiling for the church. Plywood is being placed over the boards. Two layers of insulation will be placed on the plywood. Then another layer of plywood will be installed. After that, the shingles (they are metal but look like shingles) will be installed.

Soon, the existing north end wall and exterior doors in main hallway will be removed.

Hopefully, by the end of next week (September 15th) the ceiling will be installed in the rooms in the office addition.


The floor tile in the bathrooms has been installed. Wall tile will be installed soon. After they are installed, the bathroom fixtures will be installed.

What do these roles do??


