#### A Message from Father



#### The Balance between Love and Law

Living life is more than following a set of laws. Our faith is based on the love God. In order to live our faith, we need to follow laws. It gives us order. It is a way of life for us.

In 1954, William Golding wrote a popular novel called "Lord of the Flies." The manuscript was rejected by many publishers. It's a story about a group of boys who were stranded on an island. At first everything went well for the boys. They enjoyed the adventure of exploring the island and being on their own.

However, things changed. Complaining starts to happen. Fights began. The group broke up into two rival groups. They became savages.

One of the points of this novel is that left to itself, human nature turns violent. Without laws and structures to guide it, human nature tends towards evil. Human nature takes the path of the easy way out. The author proves that we need laws and structures to survive. Otherwise, nothing is sacred; no one is respected.

The ancient Jews spent much time writing laws. This is good. It was necessary. But there were so many laws to follow. Common people gave up trying to follow the laws. They were discouraged. As a result, they were rejected as outcasts.

In today's Gospel (Matthew 23.1-12), Jesus challenges the scribes and Pharisees about their laws that result in heavy burdens. Jesus tells us that the love of God is above all things. We are to love our neighbors as ourselves.

If we follow the law but do not have the love of God or neighbor, we have missed the point of law and religion.

St Paul writes in the I Corinthians 13.2-7: "If I have all faith so as to move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give away everything I own... but do not have love, I gain nothing...."

Laws are meant to guide us. But the love of God is the fulfillment of the law.

#### **Building Project Update**

Our church building project is on schedule. Because of the weather conditions we are experiencing, the bricklayers have had delays. We have two choices about this situation. We can shut down the bricklaying project until spring. That will move our completion date to a later date. Or, we shelter the project. That means putting up scaffolding covered in plastic and providing heat so the bricklaying can continue throughout the winter. This expense would cost us \$50,000.00 to \$70,000.00. Because of the shorter days of winter, work would start at a later time in the morning and earlier time at the end of the day. We would only gain a month and a half of work with this proposal. I brought this issue to the Parish Council at our October 26<sup>th</sup> meeting. The Parish Council voted unanimously to shut down the project of sheltering for the winter. Work in other areas can continue to be done this winter. This was a good decision for our project.

The steeple of the church will be built up to the bottom of the roofline of the church. The rest of the steeple will be built next year. Work on the bathrooms is being done. Work on insulation on the church roof continues.


