Using our Talents

This is the second to the last Sunday of the Church's liturgical year. Like last week's theme, it's a time for us to reflect on the end of our lives and the end of the world. Today's Scripture readings focuses on how we use our God-given talents during our lives.

Many years ago, there was a 38 year old woman who wished she had good looks compared to celebrities or actresses. "If I could only be as good looking as they are." She would also compare herself to singing artists with such beautiful voices. "If I could only sing as beautifully as the can." She did not have these qualities. She stopped crying about what she didn't have and started to think about what she had. She remembered that in high school, she had the ability to make people laugh. People thought she was the funniest girl around. She changed her life by focusing on her gift to make people laugh. This woman became a celebrity herself! She became a comedian. Her name was Phyllis Diller. By the 1960's, she was making \$1 million a year. That was a huge salary in those days (actually, it's a huge salary even today).

What are your God-given talents? Do you share them? Do you hide them? Over the years, I recall people who are gifted musicians that didn't want their gift by helping with music at Masses. They didn't want to spend the time to do this. But there are gifted musicians that share their gifts with the parish community by serving them at Masses. This is such a blessing.

In today's Gospel (Matthew 25:14-30), Jesus tells a parable about talents. The master gives three individuals talents according to their abilities. One received five; another received three; and the last one received one. The first two did well. The last one buried the one talent he had. He was thrown out because he did nothing with what he was given.

Jesus' message is very direct. Four points for our consideration:

1. God gives each person different gifts for his/her intended uses.
 - a. Gifts are meant to be given back to Him and the community.
2. The greater the work and the more talent we have, the greater is our responsibility.
 - a. We are to make the best use of our gifts and share them.
3. The lazy and unproductive will be punished.
 - a. If one fails to use his/her talents, it will be given to others.
4. God blesses generous sharers and punishes the selfish hoarders.
 - a. We are blessed when we share our gifts. Those who selfishly preserve their own gifts will lose them.

The main theme of the three readings is an invitation to live in such a way that we make the best use of the talents God has given us, so that at the hour of our death Our Lord will say: "Well done, my good and faithful servant!... Come and share the joy of your master" Mt 25: 21).

Building Project Update

The office addition will be completed and turned over to our parish on December 4th! Final details are being completed.

The metal roof (that look like shingles) will be put on next year when the masonry work is completed. The brick work has been halted until next year when warmer temperatures return. The steeple tower will be completed next year. The church windows (not the stained glass yet) are on order.

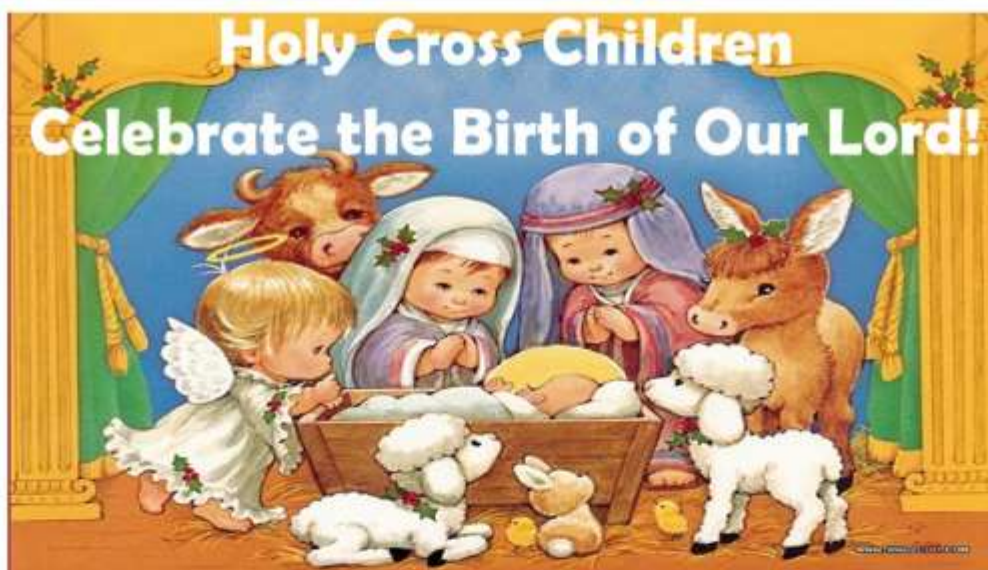
